

SCOTTISH CREST Fine Fescue Mixture is a mixture of improved varieties of Fine Fescue; Chewings, Hard, Creeping Red and Sheep Fescue. These resourceful species can be used for low maintenance lawns in many different environments. Other applications include wild-life cover, roadsides, wildflower areas, golf course fairways, tees, roughs, and low maintenance slopes for soil erosion.

Management Tips

Performs well in sun or shade. 2-4 pounds of N during a growing season is sufficient to produce a healthy turf. First mowing may begin 2-3 weeks after emergence. Best adapted from the transition zone northward, Northwest and North-east.

Seeding Rates

4-6 pounds per square feet or 200-250 pounds per acre. Germination will occur in 5-10 days after seeding under ideal conditions.

Chewings Fescue-Jamestown IV. Lush dark green color that proves a uniform turf. Excellent resistance to snow mold, dollar spot and red thread.

Hard Fescue-Rhino. Dwarf, low growing deep green color with an aggressive crown. Flourish in low fertility and infrequent irrigation.

Sheep Fescue-Barok. Unique dehydration avoidance mechanism that exhibits drought and arid climate heat tolerance.

Creeping Red Fescue-Trapeze. Improved turf quality with excellent density due to its aggressive rhizomes. Resistant to powdery mildew and red thread.
